

Background

The Spotlight on Quality in Continuous Improvement aims to:

- Recognize quality in the application of improvement principles, methods, and tools in continuous improvement
- Inspire those just starting
- Support those wanting to get better at how they pursue their efforts
- Celebrate and learn from those who are making real progress



Spotlight Application Categories

1

Improvement Project Teams

An Improvement Project Team applicant should demonstrate how they used improvement tools and methods to make significant progress on a wellspecified aim.

2

Organizational Transformation

An Organizational Transformation applicant should show how their organization applied improvement principles, methods, and tools to foster new normative practices across the organization.

3

Improvement Networks

An Improvement Network applicant should show how an intentionally structured network made up of several teams or organizations worked together to make significant progress on a shared improvement aim.

Should you consider applying?

Yes, if:

- Your work was informed by improvement principles, and drew on specific improvement methods and tools
- You can provide evidence of measurable educational improvements at some significant scale
- You have qualitative and quantitative data for tracking progress and informing subsequent improvement efforts
- We are especially interested in applicants that have used these approaches to advance more ambitious student learning goals and/ or attack longstanding disparities, by race/ethnicity or income, in students' progress through school and educational attainment.



Why consider applying?

- Be publicized nationally as leaders in the field of education improvement
- Inspire others to take up these quality improvement approaches with similar rigor
- Learn from and develop colleagueship with other Spotlight honorees
- Receive special recognition at two Carnegie Foundation events:
 - The **Spotlight on Quality in Continuous Improvement Symposium** scheduled for November 15, 2018, in Washington, DC
 - The 6th annual **Carnegie Foundation Summit on Improvement in Education,** scheduled for April 16-18, 2019, in San Francisco, CA
- Be featured in educative videos and written cases



Expectations of Spotlighted Groups

Leaders from spotlighted organizations, project teams, and improvement networks will be expected to:

How To Apply

- Download the category-specific application (available at <u>www.carnegiefoundation.org/spotlight</u>)
- Each application contains 3 parts
 - Part One: General questions for all 3 categories
 - Part Two: Specific questions for each category
 - Part Three: Evidence of continuous improvement in each category
- The online application must be submitted within a single session. Prepare your responses (text only, no tables or graphics) in a Word document, and then copy/paste your responses into the text boxes. The online form will not allow you to save and return to a partially completed application.
- Please note that there is a 4000 character limit (~500 words) for each response / text box
