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NIOST's work includes the development and refinement of statewide assessment tools for 21st CCLC, along with the development of online training tools and in-person training and technical assistance delivery to 21st CCLC sub-grantees. Georgia also serves as the Principal Investigator on NIOST's project work with ElevateOST in western Pennsylvania and leads NIOST's research activities for literacy skill-building in OST programs. Georgia regularly presents on topics related to program quality, measurement, and staff training to OST audiences around the country. Georgia is the Managing Editor of the *Afterschool Matters* journal. Georgia and her NIOST colleagues edited the recently released book "The Heartbeat of the Youth Development Field: Professional Journeys of Growth, Connection, and Transformation" which is a new volume in the series "Current Issues in Out-of-School Time" published by IAP.
